



SISTERS WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

HGE updated the water system master plan for the City of Sisters and was successful in helping the City receive 75% grant funding for the \$2.8 million project from RD and OCDBG programs. After the initial grant determination was made, HGE was able to add over 5,000 feet of waterline to the project at almost no additional cost to the City. The project included two municipal wells capable of producing 750 gpm each, new chlorination facilities, 1.6 million gallon prestressed concrete reservoir, and 22,000 lineal feet of new waterline improvements. HGE has recently added a 5,300 linear foot second transmission main for the City.

Challenges included extensive negotiations with the U.S.F.S. over easements and land for the reservoir site.

HGE has provided design and construction management for all Sisters projects developed in the past 30 years, and functions as City Engineer for this rapidly expanding community.
