In a major campus addition, a new math and science building is being added to the existing school campus. The building is designed to be compatible with existing art deco campus buildings. It will replace the original 1908 high school building, which had been converted for math and science usage and is outdated. The project consists of construction of 8 science classrooms, 11 general classrooms, a student commons, and administrative offices. The old building will be demolished at completion of the new facility.
